**State of Silence** traces the compelling stories of four journalists who risked their lives in pursuit of truth and transparency. This urgent and intimate portrait serves as a timely reminder that the freedom of the press must not be allowed to remain under siege anywhere in the world.

### LONG SYNOPSIS

**State of Silence** traces the harrowing journeys of four courageous journalists as they navigate treacherous terrain in their unwavering pursuit of truth and authenticity. In their fearless quest, these reporters shed light on the enduring suffering and anxiety experienced by their fellow citizens, even two decades after the so-called war on drugs began. Their resolute commitment exposes them to the risk of reprisals, as they willingly make themselves targets. Each person takes on the roles of investigator, chronicler, and victim, immersing themselves in the unimaginable violence perpetuated by the intersection of organized crime syndicates and corrupted local governments, known as the narcopolitical system. Through this deeply personal exploration, the narrative urgently underscores the endangered state of press freedom in Mexico. As we witness daily news reports, it is evident that journalists worldwide are facing severe threats to their fundamental right to freedom of speech. "State of Silence" is a film that offers an intimate portrayal of the dire situation in Mexico, transcending borders to become a representation of a global issue that requires urgent attention.



### DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

"As a director of documentaries, I have always had great respect for journalists. Their work shapes us. It allows us to understand the world, and often, we act or think based on their interpretation of certain events. In Mexico, mistreatment of journalists occurs on many levels, from discrediting the profession to the most lethal consequences.

This documentary shows the government's inaction and denial in the face of this violent crisis. Several administrations have come and gone, yet the problem only intensifies and journalists find themselves reporting their own deaths. Exhibiting this documentary is both an opportunity and a starting point to amplify the debate, with the intention that politicians and media industry leaders finally commit to address and sort out the issue".

Santiago studied documentary film at the National Film & Television School (NFTS) and an MA in screenwriting at the London Film School (LFS). He has been selected and supported by institutions such as FONCA's Jóvenes Creadores, IMCINE, the Berlinale's Talent Campus and Doculab at the Guadalajara International Film Festival. Both in fiction and documentary, his work has led him to appear at festivals in America, Europe and Africa. His debut feature Truenos de San Juan was selected in more than 15 film festivals and won Best Documentary at the San Diego Latino Film Festival (SLFF). He co-directed the Netflix series Reasonable Doubt; and is the director of the two seasons of the documentary series led by Gael García Bernal 'The Issue'; and the documentary State of Silence, produced by Diego Luna. He is currently the director of the documentary department at La Corriente del Golfo.


